Stonebridge Environment Update

Tree Mapping Project - Phase II

Last October, we applied for our second grant through the City of Ottawa's Community Environmental Projects Grants Program (CEPGP). We were successful in this endeavour and received the necessary funding from the city to continue with the second phase of our Tree Mapping project.

This phase includes tree mapping of our community's street trees on the East side of Stonebridge. In so doing, we hope to better gauge our Ash tree locations that will assist us in dealing with the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB).

Monarch's Proposed Development on Hole 5

Monarch is planning to add 11 single family homes on the 5th hole of the golf course. Monarch did not originally plan to build at this location and a commitment not to build in this location was provided to homeowners in the vicinity.

Stonebridge residents are strongly opposed to this infill development application for a variety of reasons including:

- Traffic Safety Issues and Notable Tree Clearing
- Residents' Loss of Privacy and Decrease in Property Values
- Changes to the 5th Hole of the Golf Course

The public consultation for the application under review was held on Dec. 2, 2013 (D07-16-13-0021 3700 Jockvale Rd.). Approximately 80 members of the community attended. Jan Harder was in attendance and heard objections raised by the community. Monarch presented material related to their application that had not been made accessible to the public in advance. The SCA submitted their concerns to Jan Harder and have requested another public consultation.

Since then Jan Harder has had a traffic specialist and golf course design specialist assess the safety of the application on our behalf. The results of these studies are available on the SCA website. 
Kilbirnie Skating Rink
